

Seeking God's face (2 Chronicles 7:14)

Let us come to the LORD and seek His face at all times, for He is a faithful God and loving Father.

Combing through the Bible, there are an astonishing number of verses where New and Old Testament writers wrote about seeking God. Now, as children of GOD and followers of Jesus Christ, we all are called to seek and draw near to HIM. Sharing a testimony of God's grace as I seek Him:

Heart of repentance: I was not really sure what I had done wrong so I humbly asked the Holy Spirit to point out my sin. I quickly realized that it was my self-reliance (relying on my own efforts and wisdom at work), so I brought it before God – acknowledging I needed Him and that I wanted to rely on His wisdom to do my work. The Holy Spirit may prompt you differently, through a vision or word.

Seeking with curiosity and expectation: There's really no perfect prayer, I exercised my will to seek God and then this sense of peace came over and I thanked God for answering my prayer. Peace was not what I asked for, but yes, it was what I needed (more than the long list of prayer requests). I did continue to ask Him for the more critical requests and I can feel He was so close to me.

Almighty God, You created us with a longing, a hunger and thirst for You, we now willingly seek You. Speak O Lord, Your servant is listening. In Jesus's Name. Amen.

Grace Star and One Youth (Proverbs 22:6)

We thank You, Father God, for all our brothers and sisters for their patience, creativity and faithfulness in serving in Grace Star and One Youth. Keppel Hill


(left lane of the slope)
