The Year of the Lord's Favour

Isaiah 61:1-4 (NIV)

- He has sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners,
- ² to proclaim the year of the LORD's favour and the day of vengeance of our God,

- and provide for those who grieve in Zion—
- to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes,

the oil of joy

instead of mourning,

and a garment of praise

instead of a spirit of despair.
